

ARTICLE X—AMENDMENTS

- Section 1: Amendments may be proposed by ten percent (10%) of the active members, a majority of the Representative Council or by two-thirds (2/3) of the Executive Board.
- Section 2: This Constitution may be amended by two-thirds (2/3) vote of the active members voting by secret ballot, provided that at least one-third (1/3) of the active members shall have cast ballots, and that notice, in writing, of the proposed amendment shall have been filed with the President, and shall have been read at a meeting of the Representative Council at least fifteen (15) school days before it is to be acted upon, in accordance with the provisions of Section 3 of this Article.
- Section 3: Any adopted amendment(s) shall become effective immediately upon ratification unless otherwise specified in the amendment.
