## ARTICLE V—EXECUTIVE BOARD

Section 1: The Executive Board shall expedite in every way possible the legislative and executive business of the Representative Council. It shall consider all matters presented for consideration of the Council between meetings and shall make a report with recommendations at each meeting of the Council. It shall serve as an executive body in all matters delegated to it. All actions taken by the Executive Board shall be binding unless repealed.

Section 2: The Executive Board, upon recommendation of the President, may require a member to resign as a chairperson or member of any committee.

Section 3: The Executive Board, in establishing a time and place of any meeting of the membership, shall give not less than ten (10) school days notice. Notice for all meetings shall be deemed sufficient upon mailing to the members the information pertaining thereto at either his/her home or his/her school address or email; or by posting same upon the CCEA bulletin board at each school; or by publishing same in the organization's newsletter, provided that the same is mailed/emailed or delivered within the time limits herein specified.
